Dear Parents,

Days roll by too fast. Counting the days 'til the end of the school year -62, counting the weeks -12, counting the months -3. March is the green month, as spring season is upon us. Most of all a sober one as Lent Liturgical season begins this Wednesday, called ASH WEDNESDAY.

Ash Wednesday is the beginning of Lent. Henri Nouwen once described winter and spring struggle with each other for dominance. I think this is an appropriate image because during this time of year the darkness and light within each of us can become locked in conflict. We are called not only to examine the integrity of our own motives but to work courageously for justice in the world around us.

Lent which means traditionally is a six-week period of abstinence and repentance in preparation for Easter. As the buds open on trees and the days lengthen, this is a spiritual season, which calls for greater openness to the word of God and a conversion in every area of our lives. It is a time to face the darkness within and expose it through our reconciliation with God.

Lent is a time to consider God's love and our sins, to repent and seek to do better. It is a time to reflect on our spiritual state and our response to God's immense love for each one of us. Lent is a time of returning to God. It is a time to confess how we keep looking for joy, peace and satisfaction in the many people and things surrounding us, without really finding what we desire. Only God can give us what we want. So we must reconcile with God, as Paul says and "let that reconciliation be the basis of our relationships with others." Lent is a time of refocusing, of re-entering the place of truth, of reclaiming our true identity. A time of personal and spiritual growth.

Lent is a solemn time, but it is not meant to be a miserable one. Sorrow for our sins and for the suffering of our Lord is, in God's mercy, a means of growth in a more joyful and richer life of faith. We may want to keep before us one of the most comforting and encouraging sayings of Jesus: "I came that they may have life, and have it more abundantly" (John 10:10).

As Catholic school it is our mission to bring our family to the Catholic faith. This month make us one step closer again to Jesus as we observe the Lenten practices of prayers, fasting and alms giving.

As we enter into the month of March, we ask God to grant us the grace to embrace each day with hope and gratitude. Help us to find peace in life's simple joys and live with purpose, always mindful of God's presence.

We are now in the JUBILEE YEAR, also known as the HOLY YEAR, the time which God's holiness transform us. God never ceases to offer us His mercy. During the jubilee year, the complete remission of sin will be granted to all the faithful truly repentant, confess their sins, receive Holy Communion.
